Your Excellency,

Being a media person keeping track of and reporting about important cases involving high profile politicians and other prominent personalities in all parts of India, I am writing this with regard to the fact that the present Chief Justice of India Mr. Altamas Kabir is one of the most corrupt Chief Justice that India has ever seen, which is a disgrace and shame to the Judiciary and to the whole of India.

I had given representation about the corruption and misdeeds by the former Chief Justice of India Sri. K.G. Balakrishnan and his near relatives who had aided him in his corrupt practice, to the former President of India which stood proved. The present Chief Justice is indulging in corrupt practice to much higher level than the former Chief Justice Sri. K.G. Balakrishnan.

- A. His agents mainly are his son Mr. Deepcham Kabir and his daughter Mrs. Anamika Kabir, her husband Mr. Disoja. Further agents are Mrs. Kabir Sukla Sinha and her husband Mr. Manasa Sinha who are his close relatives. In any cases that are being posted before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir, any person interested can approach the aforementioned persons, who will see to it that positive judgments are rendered by CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir, for which huge amount involving crores will be charged as bribe. This can be proved if the phone calls that has come to Mr. Deepcham Kabir's personal mobile number (09874870001) is examined. It will clearly reveal that all the calls that have come to this number will be from top company executives and others who are financially very well off in the society. The matter should enquired through C B I.

Yet another example is with regard to the 2 G spectrum scam incident which is the brain child of Mr. Sunil Bharathi Mittal, Chairman, Bharathi Airtel Communication Ltd., and Mr. Ravi Ruia, Chairman, ESSAR Mobile. The special Court hearing the 2 G Spectrum case had issued summons to both of them to appear before the court on 11.4.2013. The 2G scam spectrum case was heard by the Bench headed by Hon'ble Justice Singhvi in Supreme Court. On a special mention before the CJI Mr. Altamas

Kabir, the case was posted before the Chief Justice of India and CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir heard and the matter and passed interim order permitting the non appearance of the aforementioned persons before the C B I Court. This was a case where more than 25 crores of rupees was involved. In the normal case CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir, should have sent the matter to the appropriate court dealing the issue as per Supreme Court roster.

- B. An identical case is with regard to "the Sahara India Pariwar" (Mr. Subbra Roy) fraud issue which involved money collected from the public. The matter was being heard by his Hon'ble Mr. Justice K S Radhakrishnan and on a special mention the case was posted before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir and time was granted for depositing payment to SEBI. The said incident sparked of much controversy among the members of the Bar and the Supreme Court Bar Association. President Mr. Krishna Mani had objected the hearing of the case before the Chief Justice of India Court and only then did he avoid the case. *It is alleged that* The above said incidents conclusively proves that foul play was going on and if any cases have been fixed and the same is mentioned out of turn before Mr. Altamas Kabir, he has no hitch in posting and hearing such cases, though the same is not to be posted before in as per roster.
- C. The case with regard to the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) involving the admission for Medical Deemed University in India, is one that will now spark off another controversy. The same has been posted before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. The introduction of the NEET has adversely effected those colleges which has been declared as Deemed University. Mr. Jagatha Rakshakan, Former Central Minister of State (DMK Party Member) along with some colleges from Bangalore, Chennai and Mumbai has challenged the introduction of NEET. The outcome of the case can be predicted, that it will go in favour of the Medical Deemed University Colleges since the case has been posted before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. It is pertinent to point out that NEET has been introduced by the Medical Council of India. Mr. Jagatharakshakan is the owner of two Deemed University Colleges and he is also the main money collection agent for other Medical Deemed University owners.
- D. Another allegation is with regard to the foul play involved by CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir in the posting of judges at Supreme Court. For example there are three judges who have been promoted and posted from the Delhi High Court and there have been three judges who have been posted in the Supreme Court from the Bombay High Court. It is pertinent to point out that no judges have been posted from Madhya Pradesh to the Supreme Court and no judges have been posted as Chief Justice of any High Court from Orissa. There should be at least two judges posted as High Court Chief Justice from the State of Uttar Pradesh and two judges to be posted as Supreme Court Judges, whereas at present only a one judge has been posted in the Supreme Court and only a one judge has been posted as High Court Chief Justice from U.P.
- E. It is also pertinent to bring to attention, the unholy nexus between CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir and the present Attorney General G Vahanvati. Senior

Counsel Mr. Hareesh Salve and Senior Counsel Mr. Mukul Rohtagi. These three enjoy unfettered freedom and control before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. It is a public secret in Supreme Court corridor that if any cases are to be dealt with before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir these three persons can be approached. Mr. G Vahanvati will give any legal opinion if it involves fixing of cases before CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. The much controversial case from Kerala which involves firing and killing of innocent fishermen by two Italian Marines is one such case. The case ought to have been tried by the specially constituted court at Kerala. Instead in order to help the marines, on the advise of the Attorney General Mr. G Vahanvati the case has been transferred to CMM Court, Delhi by CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir Bench. Poor innocent Malayalee/Kerela fishermen and their family who can depose only in Malayalam will be put to deep trouble since the case has been transferred to a court at Delhi. Though the State of Kerala had made every effort to post the case for trial at Kerala all efforts have turned futile (Now the case enquiry conducted from CBI or NIA not clear).

- F. The direct evidence of highly influential clients capability to approach CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir can be proved by the case of one Mr. Alex Joseph whose case with regard to import of foreign car which is pending before the CBI Special Court, Chennai. He had gone to the residence of CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir five times. At the time of visit to the residence of CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir the visit has to be recorded at the gate and sanction has been given by Mr. P. P Sharma, Principle Secretary to CJI who is also highly corrupt. The visitor report book at the gate (5, Krishnan Menon Marg) and the mobile number of Mr. Sharma (9818133393) also if examined will bring to light the truth about the incident. He has gone to the residence of CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir in vehicle bearing registration.No: DL-5CD-7675. There is also I B report with regard to the fact. The said issue has also to be ordered to be enquired by the CBI.
- G. Former Justice Aftab Alam who retired recently on 18.4.2013 and who was also highly corrupt and enjoyed high freedom with CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. Cases were specially allotted to his court by CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir and one of his relative Mr. Hussain from Patna was the main agent for fixing the cases. The famous 'Mr. Amith Shah case' (Former Home Minister of Gujarat), i.e. the fake encounter case were bail was granted by the Gujarat High Court and was confirmed by the Supreme Court after one and half years was one such case heard by Mr. Aftab Alam. Necessarily this has also to be enquired by the CBI, especially about Mr. Hussain's visit to Mr. Aftab Alam's residence from Patna to Delhi by flight. Ticket details are enclosed for kind perusal.
- H. Mr. Justice S.R. Bobde and Mr. M Y Iqbal were elevated to the Supreme Court from the High Courts of Madhya Pradesh and Madras respectively. These appointments were made after huge amount of money were taken as bribe by CJI son's from the aforementioned two judges for elevation to the Supreme Court of India.
- I. The Muslim spirit and Muslim cocus by CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir can be proved by verifying the posting of certain judges Chief Justice D Murukesan of Delhi High Court

is due to retire on 10.6.2013 in which case Mr. Justice B D Ahammed of Delhi High Court will become the acting Chief Justice of Delhi. But he is a Muslim. Mr. Justice I A Ansari from Guwahati High Court is going to be posted as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court. Hence the capital city of India two prominent judges who will be heading the collegium of Delhi High Court will be Muslims which will facilitate the appointment of Muslim Judges in future. It is pertinent to point out that former Mr. Justice A M Ahmadi while he was the Chief Justice of India used to take steps for appointment of more number of Muslim Judges to various High Courts in India. But there was no allegation of corruption involved in making such appointments. But in the case of CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir there is also allegation of taking of bribe in making appointments.

J. After the retirement of CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir, Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam will assume charge as new Chief Justice of India on 19.7.2013. He is also a person without any integrity. This can be proved from the fact that SLP (Crl) No: 9706/2012 Nimma Gadda Prasad Vs. CBI and SLP (Crl) 5946/2012 CBI Vs. V. Vijaya Sai Reddy and SLP (Crl) 3404/2013 Y.S Jagmohan Reddy Vs. CBI which are notorious cases involving crores of rupees and where the Andhra Pradesh High court had granted bail to Vijaya Sai Reddy, the main accused almost one and a half year back (Grand Bail from Andhra High Court) and against which the CBI has preferred special leave before the Supreme Court, has been managed to be posted before Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam. The case has been pending before the Supreme Court for almost one and half years and it has been heard only very recently i.e. four or five days back. This is a case involving almost around 28,000/- crores of rupees. The allegation is with regard to transfer of crores of rupees India to foreign country. The CBI has taken great pain in investigating the case. The special leave preferred by the CBI ought to have been considered much earlier. In such cases when the prime accused has been let scot-free by being on bail, it would definitely hamper the investigation of the case and all the efforts taken by the CBI. As per registry rules these cases ought to have been posted before the bench headed by Mrs. Justice Gyan Sudha Misra. Mr. R. Maithani is at present the Registrar- posting. He is also a person who is highly corrupt. Any cases can be posted before appropriate benches as per the choice of the litigant if huge amount is paid as bribe. I had sent application under the RTI Act seeking information questioning the posting of the above mentioned cases in deviation from the Supreme Court roster and I am enclosing a copy of the same. The famous 'Disproportionate Asset case' of Mis. Mayavathi, Former Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh is one such case which was managed to be posted before Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam, deviating from the posting as per roster. In the said case the FIR was quashed Supreme Court and at present a review has been filed against the quashing of the FIR and the review also hearing and judgment reserved.

Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam is a person who was supposed to be closely associated with former CJI Mr. K.G. Balakrishnan and will do anything as directed by him. The son in law of former CJI Mr. K.G Balakrishnan Mr. Sreenijan and Kerala High Court driver Mr. Selvam (close family friend of Justice K G Balakrishnan) are supposed to be the agents of Mr. Justice Sathasivam. The two children (Mr. Srinivasan and

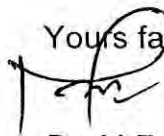
Senthil) of Mr. Justice Sathasivam were working at Singapore. Recently they have migrated to Coimbatore and the elder son Mr. Sreenivasan has started a Maruti Showroom at Coimbatore. They are also the close associate of corporate link of Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam. The source of income the aforementioned persons are to be enquired by the CBI.

While Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam was posted as a government pleader as the Madras High Court, Mr. Dalavasundaram, lawyer of the ADMK party was also a government pleader along with Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam. He claims that he can get any orders from the bench of Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam. He is also an agent of Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam. His mobile number is 09444990009. Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam will have a tenure of around nine months as the Chief Justice of India. Hence the above stated facts also has to be enquired by the CBI.

- K. The Attorney General, Mr. G Vahanvati enjoys a special clout with CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir. Sincere officers like Additional Solicitor General Mr. Harin Raval and Former Solicitor General Mr. Gopal Subramaniam were forced to resign and were made scape goats owing to this unholy nexus between CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir and Mr. G Vahanvati.
- L. As stated earlier CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir is the most corrupt Chief Justice that India has ever seen. In view of the for going, your Excellency is requested to kindly get a thorough investigation done by the CBI on the Chief Justice of India, CJI Mr. Altamas Kabir and also about his entire family members for finding out as to how much financial assets they have accumulated since he took over as the Chief Justice of India, as the details of the immovable property/assets declared by him and his wife on 1.4.2012 (copy of which is enclosed) in Supreme Court Website is far below than the actual assets he and his family now own and also about all other above stated issues to the Director, CBI for thorough enquiry.
